

Volunteer Opportunities

As a member-run club volunteering is needed from all our members.

If you are not currently on any of these teams and have an interest in helping out on any one of them please let Pete Shanahan (actonindoortennis@gmail.com) know. The shoveling team is the team that needs the most help currently.

Emergency Team: If there becomes a situation where the Bubble either needs to come down or is at risk of coming down the Emergency Team is called. All objects which could tear the bubble need to be lowered (lights, tennis nets, separating net) or moved out from under the bubble (benches, trash cans, etc.). A team of 6-10 people can get the task taken care of in half an hour or so. The emergency team would also be called to set things back up when the risk of the bubble coming down has passed. Emergencies are infrequent but should there be a need to call the team, the expectation is that the members will, if at all possible, make their way to the club to help.

Weeding Team: We need a few people to weed the clay courts during the summer. Work takes place primarily during July and August.

Shoveling Team: This team in particular needs some additional volunteers. The shovelers are called, on a rotating basis, when it snows in excess of six inches. We shovel out the emergency door in the back of the club, create a path from the parking lot to the emergency door, create a path to the front door of the club, and create a path for the oil guys to reach the oil tank. Generally 3-4 shovelers can complete the work in about an hour. The team is generally called within 12 hours of the snow ending.
